The Nye Community Foundation Scholarship

The Nye Community Foundation was formed by the residents of Nye, Montana to support facilities and programs in Nye and the surrounding areas. Funds raised are donated to local institutions such as the Nye Volunteer Fire Department and the Nye School and also invested in the Montana Community Foundation for future projects.

The Foundation supports new graduates in furthering their education, whether in college, trade school, community colleges, or specialized training. With good grades, community involvement and volunteering, the Foundation offers ongoing support until the end of your chosen program, with the possibility of support in some Graduate studies.

Preference will be given to Nye area students and surrounding community students who are active in community service in the Nye area. Our emphasis is community service:

Eligibility Rules

1. Applicant must be a resident of the Absarokee High School District, and applicant must be a member in good standing of the current graduating class of Absarokee High School, or a past graduate of Absarokee High School.
2. Applicant must be planning on entering his or her freshman year of college or another year of undergraduate study.
3. Applicants' community service must be volunteer and not required.

Award

The winners will be awarded the scholarship paid directly to their institutions upon successful completion of one semester of full time study and proof of re-enrollment.

Criteria

The scholarships will be awarded based on the following criteria:

1. Leadership in school
2. Community service.
3. Academic achievement/evidence of academic improvement
4. A personal statement prepared by the applicant.
5. The Nye Community Foundation Scholarship Committee may interview finalists.

Deadline

All applications shall be **typewritten** and postmarked by **APRIL 1, (current year)**.

Incomplete applications will not be considered.
