Nye Community Foundation Gifts To The Community And Beyond

Since its founding in 1999, the Nye Community Foundation has worked diligently to raise funds for the support of our school, volunteer fire department, scholarship program, and for the support of neighboring area facilities, activities, and programs. In seven years, over \$37,000 has been given in gifts. The NCF has provided \$12,000 in scholarships to graduates of Absarokee High School. The Nye School and the Nye Volunteer Fire Department have received \$9000, and \$6000, respectively. In addition, the NCF has supported the Absarokee Recreation Association, the AYSO, and the Absarokee pool with gifts totaling \$7,500. Others receiving financial help were the Absarokee Music and Drama Department, Skip's Kids, and the Nye Elementary Hunger Fighters. This year the Derby Fire Relief Fund, in collaboration with the Beartooth Stockgrowers Association, received \$1000 from the NCF. The community of Nye, Montana, through the Nye Community Foundation is proud to give this help and will continue to do so with the support of their friends and neighbors.



Our Scholarship Winners...and what they are doing

NYE---This year the Nye Community Foundation awarded six scholarships, totaling \$5,400. Four of these scholarships were given to 2006 graduates of Absarokee High School, and two went to area students now attending college. Three of the scholarships to high school graduates were for \$800, and one was for \$1,000. These were funded by the Foundation. The two \$1,000 scholarships for college students were provided by Friends of the Foundation. Recipients of the \$800 scholarships are Tyler Jahn, Cort Ratliff and BrandonWiliams. The three \$1,000 awards went to Nicole Naasz, a 2006 high school graduate, and Cassie Keogh and Whitney DeVilbiss, who are attending college.

Tyler Jahn, the son of Larry Jahn of Fishtail and Jill Jahn of Absarokee, is attending Montana Tech in Butte and will earn a bachelor's degree in petroleum engineering. In high school he was Student Council president, class president in his junior year, belonged to the Drama, Pep and Chess Clubs, and participated in football and track.

Cort Ratliff, the son of Larry and Pam Ratliff of Nye, is attending the University of Montana at Missoula to earn a degree in music. During all four years of high school, he was in the Honor Band, the Jazz Band, was on the Honor Roll and participated in basketball and soccer.

Brandon Williams, the son of Ron and Ginger Williams of Absarokee, is attending the Southern University of Virginia and is working toward a degree in business or sports medicine. For four years in high school he was active in football, basketball, baseball, the Band, Jazz Band, and the Pep Club. He recently earned the Eagle Scout Award, given by the Boy Scouts of America.

Nicole Naasz, the daughter of Todd Naasz of Glendive and Roxi Sorlien of Absarokee, is attending Montana Tech in Butte to study for a degree in business. For four years in high school, she belonged to the Drama and Business Professionals of America (BPA) Clubs, was active in volleyball and basketball, and received All State Academic Status. She was in the Swing Choir, the Pep Choir and Husky Buddies.

Cassie Keogh, daughter of Noel and Penny Keogh of Nye and recipient of a \$1,000 scholarship, started her junior year at the University of Montana at Missoula in the fall, where she is majoring in music education and clarinet performance. She was on the Dean's List and is secretary for the local chapter of the Collegiate Music Educators National Conference (CMENC). Among her service activities are serving as a legislative page in the Montana House of Representative in 2005, tutoring music theory students, serving as head of the CMENC peer mentoring program, and serving on the student committee that evaluates the music faculty for the file of the School of Fine Arts.

Whitney DeVilbiss, the daughter of Geri DeVilbiss and J.Alex DeVilbiss, both of Absarokee and recipient of a \$1,000 award, started her second year of Montana State University, Billings College of Technology's Paramedic Program in the fall . She will graduate in the spring of 2007 with an Applied Science Degree of Paramedics. At present she is working on certifications in Prehospital Trauma Life Support and Neonate Resuscitation. Next semester she will work on Pediatric Life Support and Advance Cardiac Life Support certifications. Since 2004, she has been active in the Absarokee Volunteer Ambulance Service.
